LA WATERSHED INITIATIVE UPDATES	Pat Forbes, Executive Director of the Louisiana Office of Community Development (OCD) provided an update on the LWI program. Pat oversees the state's Community Development Block Grant programs funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Pat's oversight includes housing, economic development, infrastructure, and planning programs for hurricane recovery, the Small Cities program, and the Louisiana Watershed Initiative. Pat Forbes did ask what were the RSC's thoughts on the LWI Outreach Video – more specific videos are needed to show the work that has been and is being done by RSCs; we should have had this video much earlier.	
SUB-COMMITTEE REPORT OUTS		
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM	The CIP Subcommittee met on January 6, 2022. LWI updated the subcommittee on the Design Support Pilot Program and Round 2. Round 1 project applications that were unfunded but are still viable will have rolling announcements for the Design Support and Pilot Program. Round 2 project funding is expected to be announced at the end of 2022. FEMA BRIC funding could be applied to the Upper Bayou Nezpique Project, which involves the installation of retention ponds for watershed protection, flood prevention, agricultural water management and recreation. The Evangeline Parish Police Jury did not purse BRIC funding this year, but plan to do so next year. This regional project would benefit 6 parishes in Region 5 in the Mermentau Watershed. Additional project meetings will be scheduled this year in preparation for next year's FEMA BRIC application. The Region 5 Action Plan was updated and reviewed. The Region 5 Comprehensive Project Inventory is complete. There is an online survey link that will soon be distributed to each parish in Region 5 to begin collecting past, present or conceptual regional watershed projects. Parishes can present on their projects at the next steering committee meeting in April.	
GOVERNANCE AND LONG-TERM SUSTAINIABILITY	The Governance & Long-Term Sustainability Subcommittee was scheduled to meet on 01/20, but the meeting was canceled. We decided to cancel the meeting as we had no update on the legislative packet. The next Governance meeting is scheduled for 03/17.	
WATERSHED MODELING UPDATE – LA DOTD	Billy Williamson is the Program Manager of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development's Statewide Flood Control Program. This program is designed to help solve flood problems through an active, innovative approach. This Program uses state funds allocated each year by the Legislature to assist in the construction of flood control
