The Transportation Technical Committee will consider a motion to approve TIP Amendment No. 13.</u> ~ ~ ~ ~ ~</p> <p>Public Comment ~ ~ ~ ~ ~</p> <p><i>Ms. Sara Gary presented the 2023-2026 TIP Amendment No. 13. She reported all the modifications before the close of FY 25 moving to FY 26. Anything not completed in 2025 is moving to 2026. She discussed the removal of Bonin Rd. in Youngsville who decided to move the money to another project. She discussed the construction removal from 2027 to 2028 for the round-about at LA -95 at Lexington Dr. She discussed other projects extensions and phases for LCG and DOTD that are moving from FY 2026-2027 and 2027 to 2028. <p>Safety Performance Measures Action Requested</p>	<p><u>Staff will present the Safety Performance Measures for 2026. The Transportation Technical Committee will consider a motion to modify the MTP to include the 2026 Safety Performance Measures.</u> ~ ~ ~ ~ ~</p> <p>Public Comment ~ ~ ~ ~ ~</p> <p><i>Ms. Ashley Moran presented the Safety Performance Measures. She compared the current motor vehicle fatality crashes to previous years and the reasons for them. The analysis showed an overall decline within the years 2021-2024. She also referenced the number and type of crashes and child fatalities. She discussed the availability of free Safety child seats and the proper installation, usually for parents with expired seats or those economically unable to afford safety seats. She also discussed the expiration of child safety seats because most parents are unaware of safety seat expiration. Questions posed by members were addressed by Ms. Ashley Moran.</i></p>

It needs to be updated by March 27th. We have advertised for a consultant for a month and got Neel-Schaffer as our expert consultant to build our transportation models.
