

# FREIGHT IN ACADIANA




The Acadiana Metropolitan Planning Area is primarily serviced by three modes of freight infrastructure: truck, rail, and air.


The six parish Acadiana region facilitates inbound and outbound freight shipments from counties around the United States, Canada, and Mexico. These shipments contain a wide variety of goods across different economic sectors, for a total value of \$29.77 billion dollars (2019) and 38 million tons of goods.




### TRUCK NETWORK

The majority of freight transportation in the Acadiana region is truck movements. Truck traffic primarily concentrated on the Interstate highway system, primarily Interstate 10 that traverses St. Martin, Lafayette, and Acadia parishes.









#### **RAIL NETWORK**

Acadiana has 201 rail nodes across 247 miles of rail lines. Over 67% of of the lines are maintained by the national rail companies Burlington Northern Santa Fe and Union Pacific, with 32% of the lines under local ownership with the companies Acadiana Railway and Louisiana Delta. There are 5 Intermodal Passenger Facilities in the region.




### PIPELINE NETWORK

Natural gas is one of Acadiana's largest natural resources, and pipelines densely cross the region in all of the parishes. There are four pipeline terminals in Acadiana - one in Opelousas, two in Breaux Bridge, and one in Forked Island.



### **PORTS IN ACADIANA**

Acadiana has two primary water access facilities in the region: docks and ports. There are 289 dock facilities across all six parishes of the MPO, primarily along waterways such as rivers and bays. There is one principal port, the Port of Iberia, located just outside of the MPO area.






# FREIGHT EMPLOYMENT FACILITIES

There are a total of 5,152 freight facilities in the Acadiana region, for a total employment of 65,625 in transportation commodity industries.

Lafayette, Vermilion, and Acadia have similar numbers of facilities, between 1,000 and 1,600 facilities. St. Landry has 739 facilities, Iberia has 319 facilities, and St. Martin has 208 facilities.


The majority of workers in Acadiana freight facilities are employed in Warehouse and Distribution Centers and Farm Products.


More than half of the workers are employed in Lafayette Parish, at 33,499 total employees. Vermilion follows at 8,149 employees, Acadia at 7,599 employees, Iberia at 6,676 employees, St. Landry at 6,240, and St. Martin at 3,462 employees.

## ACADIA PARISH FREIGHT PROFILE

Acadia Parish is the westernmost parish in the Acadiana region.

It's primary freight transportation network is Interstate 10, which traverses the southern part of the parish.

BSNF and UP jointly own the rail line that mirrors I-10 to the south, along US 90.

The Mermentau River provides water access to the Gulf of Mexico's Intercoastal Waterway.



Empty freight containers, food and kindred products, and farm products have the most units shipped out of the parish.






Empty freight containers have the highest number of units that are brought into the parish.








# EVANGELINE PARISH FREIGHT PROFILE


Evangeline Parish is the northernmost parish in the Acadiana region.

Iberia Parish is the easternmost parish in the Acadiana region.

It's primary freight transportation network is US Highway 90 and LA 182 which runs a parallel north/south route to US Highway 90.


The Acadiana Regional Airport is located along US Highway 90 that provides general aviation with a fully staffed Air Traffic Control Tower.

BSNF and UP jointly own the rail line that mirrors the US 90 corridor as well as one short line operator Louisiana Delta Railroad.

The Intercoastal waterway provides the Port of Iberia access to the Gulf of Mexico.



**Iberia Parish Truck and Rail Network** 



Lafayette Parish falls at the center of the Acadiana region.


It's primary freight transportation network is Interstate 10 and Interstate 49 and US Highway 90 south of I-10.

**Lafayette Parish Truck and Rail Network** 



# ST. LANDRY PARISH FREIGHT PROFILE


St. Landry Parish is centrally located in the Acadiana region.

Acadiana Railway operates a short line freight service from Opelousas going north and meeting up with the UP line in Bunkie.




#### St. Landry Parish Truck and Rail Network

Empty freight containers account for the most units shipped out of the parish.






#### St. Martin Parish Truck and Rail Network



The Vermilion River provides the Port of Vermilion access to the Gulf of Mexico's Intercoastal Waterway.


